This includes tax indemnification, withholding tax, registered form requirements, controlled foreign corporation and section 956-related issues with guarantees and collateral, and applicable high-yield debt obligation issues.

Brandon counsels US and offshore issuers and underwriters in public offerings and private placements of securities. He has provided tax advice for private equity investments in US real estate, performing and nonperforming US loans and other debt instruments, mortgages and mortgage servicing rights (MSRs), and consumer receivables.

Brandon was a member of the Solar Access to Public Capital working group formed to increase access to securitization for solar projects with tax equity investors. He focuses on clean vehicle and investment tax credits, as well as financing for renewable energy projects and developers, including property-assessed clean energy or PACE financing.

Brandon is an advisor to many tax-exempt organizations with respect to US federal tax matters, and served on the board of the Amara Legal Center for seven years.
