At 11:45 a.m. on Saturday, February 4, Entertainment and Media partner Scott Cutrow will speak on "The Streaming Deal: End to End" session, discussing the lawyering that happens before anybody can click "play" on their favorite streaming platform, and how streaming shows and movies make it from idea to the digital screen. Speakers will discuss the role of lawyers from pitch, to shopping, to different kinds of greenlighting, and much more, as well as how that provision will stand up in litigation.
