Brian and other panelists will discuss how they became involved in an Internet-based legal practice and how they were able to get employers to support them in their efforts.

Intellectual Property attorney Michael R. Justus will moderate "Big Data and New Issues for the Trademark Practitioner" at 8:00 a.m. (PT) on Wednesday, May 6. The panel will discuss big data trademark issues and the use of big data in the practice of trademark law.
