Topics will include:

- defense strategies to avoid litigation during the notice period;

- how to neutralize citizen suit fee shifting provisions through FRCP 68 offers of judgment;
- settling with state or federal agencies in order to bar citizen suits; and
- developing proactive procedures and policies so clients can reduce the risks of citizen suits.
