

Joshua Rubenstein Provides Legal Perspective on Art Ownership and Artists Rights in *Citywealth*

In a *Citywealth* article examining the intersection of art, activism and how the output translates to commercial value, Partner and National Chair of Katten's Private Wealth department Joshua Rubenstein offered a legal perspective on art ownership.

The article aimed to provide a variety of perspectives on how art's role can influence both its financial worth and societal impact. Joshua cited a 2018 case in which a court's ruling set precedent acknowledging that graffiti is a protected art form, even in cases where it clashes with property ownership.
