Gidon has also represented corporations, their board of directors, officers, special committees, and other high-profile clients, particularly in the technology and life science sectors. He has handled internal and regulatory investigations by entities such as the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), venture fund disputes, and other complex commercial litigation.

"Very often, I'm dealing with a company in crisis. Government investigations commence, or there is a securities class action which names individuals. Imagine coming home and talking to your spouse or significant other about your day and starts off with 'I was sued for \$30 billion,'" Caine said. "The ability to take someone from 'I was sued for \$30 billion today' to 'I'm going to find a way out of this. Gidon and Katten are going to help me find a way out from underneath this' is actually, I think, a very, very good thing."
