

## Firm's Founding Partner Allan B. Muchin Receives Visionary Award from Noble Network of Charter Schools

Noble serves more than 12,000 students and 28,000 alumni across 17 open-enrollment public charter schools in Chicago, working to ensure that all students have equitable and positive school experiences that will prepare them for college and beyond.
