

Partner Gil Soffer Quoted in *Report on Medicare Compliance* on Decision in Health Fraud Case

Gil Soffer, a partner in the Firm's White Collar Criminal and Civil Litigation Practice, was quoted in *Report on Medicare Compliance* regarding a case in which a Nevada judge ordered the government to pay a physician \$280,000 in legal fees after a failed health fraud prosecution, calling some of it “frivolous.” Mr. Soffer says that, “Generally, it takes a great deal before the court will say, especially in criminal cases, that the government has acted frivolously.
