



Katten Represents NBCUniversal in *Million Dollar Decorators* Suit

Katten represented Bravo Media LLC, production company Goodbye Pictures Inc. and parent company NBCUniversal Media LLC in district court regarding alleged copyright infringement in an episode of reality show *Million Dollar Decorators*. Michael Eastman, a St. Louis photographer, accuses the show of violating the Visual Artists Rights Act of 1990 by using images of his work without the proper contractual permission. The suit stems from a *Decorators* episode in which Eastman claims an interior decorator improperly enlarged one of his photographs. Defendants reject that argument, saying Eastman gave permission to use the work and signed a clearance agreement forfeiting his right to sue.
