

Katten Represents InMarket Media in Successfully Blocking Injunction Bid

In a case pending in the New York District Court in New York City, Katten represents InMarket Media LLC and was successful in defeating a motion filed by Berkley Networks Corp. seeking to stop it from using the “inMarket” trademark for its mobile marketing platform delivered to smart phones.
