At the conference, Mr. Tully and other panelists discussed various aspects of a holistic and long-term approach to e-discovery before an audience of legal and IT professionals. In particular, Mr. Tully noted that the level of judicial tolerance for misunderstanding electronically stored information (ESI) issues is shrinking rapidly, making the need to maintain effective ESI tools all the more critical.
