Bob Morehouse joined Katten in 2013 following 39 years of business and environmental experience in consulting and the chemical and refining industries. In 2013, Bob was appointed to serve on the Clean Air Act Advisory Committee of the US EPA, a committee formed under the Federal Advisory Committee Act that routinely provides the US EPA with advice and counsel on key policy decisions relating to implementation of the Clean Air Act.
